

Local Development Business Plan Community Engagement Symposium

Background

The purpose of the <u>Local Development Business Plan</u> (LDBP) is to provide a roadmap for accelerating the deployment of local clean energy resources through Alameda County's Community Choice Energy program—East Bay Community Energy (EBCE). The LDBP Community Engagement Symposium will provide an interactive forum for review and discussion of the Draft LDBP Work Products and Scenarios.

Goals of the Symposium

Robust community stakeholder engagement has been an integral component of the LDBP project, and community input has supported the development of a unique and innovative plan that will help EBCE maximize local environmental, economic and social benefits. The LDBP Community Engagement Symposium is intended to be an important step in this extensive LDBP stakeholder engagement process. The goal of this special event is to present the core elements and themes of the anticipated plan and provide meaningful opportunities for community stakeholders to engage with the material and the LDBP Project Team and contribute to the formulation of the plan.
