# CalCCA Legislative Bill Goals

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- Clarity about CCA procurement jurisdiction
- Set standards for minimizing costs that go into fees
- Increase transparency of fees

## Next steps:

- CalCCA bill language and spot bill being submitted to Leg Council by Jan 25 (unbacked for now) – actively seeking bill sponsor
- Outreach to active partners
- CalCCA lobby day being planned in the spring

# EBCE Legislative Bill Concept

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- Promoting increased electrification to improve air quality and reduce GHG emissions

## Next steps:

- Seeking a spot bill for submission to Leg Council by Jan 25 deadline – will need to flesh out policy proposal with community and Board engagement in coming weeks
- Meetings with AlCo delegation members

# Regulatory News

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- Gov Newsom appointed Genevieve Shiroma to the CPUC to replace the vacancy left by Carla Peterman
- Incoming Cmmr. Shiroma is from Sacramento, serves on the Agricultural Labor Relations Board, and was the elected director of Ward 4 of the Sacramento Municipal Utility District from 1999-2018
- EBCE will be scheduling a meet-and-greet with the incoming Cmmr. once she begins her new role

# Regulatory Proceedings – ERRRA

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- On Jan 22 Cmmr. Guzman Aceves issued an Alternate Proposed Decision (APD) in PG&E's 2019 ERRRA Forecast proceeding
- The PD or APD could be voted on at the Feb 21 CPUC mtg
  - The APD would require PG&E to conduct a 2018 brown power true-up, which would decrease the 2019 PCIA
  - EBCE intends to seek additional *ex parte* meetings with other Commissioners before the Feb vote
- Implementation of rate changes expected April 2019

# Other Key Regulatory Proceedings

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## PG&E 2020-2022 General Rate Case (GRC)

### Application:

- EBCE and a coalition of CCAs filed protests on Jan 17 and are attending a workshop Jan 25

## PG&E Safety Culture Investigation:

- EBCE expects to file comments in response to Assigned Cmmr. Scoping Memo & Ruling on Feb 13
