Director Kalb moved to support the bill as proposed and to report this action to the Board of Directors at the March 17, 2021 meeting. Director Mei seconded the motion which carried 5/0.

Ceyda Durmaz Dogan spoke in support of creating a utility debt relief fund, and to partner with non-profits to facilitate customer enrollment into CARE and FERA. Ceyda Durmaz Dogan also spoke in support of automatic enrollment for debt relief programs.
