Blair Beekman asked questions about the October 21, 2020 Integrated Resource Plan Results report.

Audrey Ichinose spoke in support of collecting original data, stating that PGE withholds load and pricing data that impact EBCE's operations.

Vaughn asked questions about Salesforce's cloud service.

Cynthia Landry spoke in support of building an in-house call center, for the creation of local jobs within the service area that support family-friendly wages, and for developing a customer information database.
