RECOMMENDATION

Accept the CEO's report on contracts that EBCE has entered, as required by the Administrative Procurement Policy. **Items executed between October 13, 2021 and November 12, 2021:**

C-2021-104 Frontier Energy Third Amendment to CSA adds compensation in the amount of \$150,000 for a total amount not to exceed \$400,000, extends the term through March 31, 2023, and adds to the scope and updates the hourly rates of compensation.

C-2021-105 Partner Engineering and Science (Oakland) Proposal for Phase 1 Environmental Site Assessment, total amount not to exceed \$2,300.

C-2021-106 Partner Engineering and Science (Oakland) Proposal for ALTA/NSPS Land Title Survey, total amount not to exceed \$9,875

C-2021-107 Fractal Business Analytics First Amendment to CSA, extends the termination date through November 1, 2022.

C-2021-108 CALSTART (Pasadena, CA) Consulting Services Agreement for development of a zero-emission medium and heavy-duty goods movement Blueprint for EBCE's service area through November 30, 2023, for an amount not to exceed \$200,000.

C-2021-109 AIQUEOUS First Amendment to CSA expands the scope of service, adds \$60,000 to the compensation for a total amount not to exceed \$142, 500, extends term through October 31, 2022.

C-2021-110 Keyes and Fox Joint Representation Agreement, Keyes and Fox will provide joint representation to a group of CCAs for the 2020 ERRA Compliance Proceeding and the 2022 ERRA Forecast Proceeding.

C-2021-111 California Community Choice Financing Authority Memorandum of Understanding, EBCE will provide resources and staff to support CCCFA's operations and will be compensated for services.

C-2021-112 Cypress Mandela Training Center (Oakland) COVID-19 Community Relief Response Grant Agreement awarded in the amount of \$33,333 to support local green energy job programs and expedited hiring processes in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

C-2021-113 CLEAResult Third Amendment to CSA extends the term through December 31, 2022.
