- 15. Community Advisory Committee Report
 - The deepest respect for Supervisor Valle whose loss we mourn on many levels. He was an amazing leader, advocate, and poet. We send condolences to his family, friends, and all of us who were fortunate enough to work with him over the years.
 - Concern that submitted correspondence was not distributed to the Board or the CAC prior to the CAC meeting.

This prohibits discussion or consideration of public comment that was submitted in accordance with our policies. We request the Board direct staff to distribute these materials 3 days ahead of time, along with the rest of the materials for the meeting if they have been received. For example, a request was made on February 2nd for a letter to be distributed to the Board and the CAC, and we had not received it at the time the meeting was called to order on the 13th. I have received requests for meetings from some constituents, and am meeting with them to understand the issues being brought to our meetings.

Report on the status of the current FY budget through December, 2022

- **Discussion:** Staff confirmed the relationship between the increased cost of natural gas on EBCE power costs, due to high reliance on system power.
- 17. Discussion of In-Person and Teleconference Board Meetings Options After the End of the State of California COVID-19 State of Emergency, and Adopt Post-COVID Emergency Attendance Policy for East Bay Community Energy Board and Brown Act Committees (Action Item)

Provide direction to staff and adopt a Resolution approving a POST-COVID Emergency Attendance Policy (Policy) for the Board and East Bay Community Energy Brown Act committees to provide a policy with respect to conducting public meetings after the end of the State of California's COVID-19 State of Emergency, which is expected to occur on February 28, 2023.

- CAC supports staff recommendation to return to the Brown Act requirements with multiple meeting locations throughout our service territory.
- CAC encourages EBCE to join other Brown Act bodies in our service area who have kept the option to participate in a webinar format for the public.

 Increased opportunities for public engagement is only beneficial, especially as we

welcome new member cities into our jurisdiction. This recommendation is made in an effort to increase transparency and lower one of the barriers to participation for our constituents and customers, in recognition of the size of EBCEs service territory, that physical attendance at meetings is challenging for many with children, for those providing care, for those with disabilities, or for whom have limited access to public transportation. The impact commuting has on the environment, VMT and climate goals, and the time of participating members and the public was also recognized.
