






About EBCE

Program Overview

Working to deliver Solar and Storage for municipal critical facilities

- Assessed hundreds of facilities in our service area to understand characteristics + needs
- Procurement pathway based on CA § 4217.10 (TCO cost savings)
- RFO is for facilities in Phase 2 Cities: Emeryville, Livermore, Oakland and Pleasanton
- Working with members to develop future Solar + Storage procurements

Supporting portfolio economics


- City engagement and initial feasibility review informed decision to include in RFO
- EBCE applied for interconnection applications before NEM 2.0 deadline for sites with most ability to benefit from NEM 2.0



De-risking the Portfolio

EBCE time and effort on City engagement reduces developer risk + costs

- Emeryville, Livermore, Oakland and Pleasanton City
 Councils passed resolutions to sign PPA that meets cost effectiveness
- PPA issued with RFO based on extensive engagement to understand City needs
- EBCE will continue to coordinate with Cities to expedite project development with selected vendor(s)

Provision of resilience, bill savings, and load modification across the portfolio via PPA

RFO Process Overview

August 14, 2023 no later than 5pm	Deadline for submission of Attachment A: Statement of Qualifications.	
No later than August 16, 2023	 EBCE notifies respondents of shortlisting results. EBCE will provide Attachment F for signature (provided for respondent review with RFO attachments) to shortlisted respondents as quickly as possible after shortlisting. Shortlisted respondents will receive access to Attachment G: Site data upon full execution of Attachment F: NDA. 	
August 25, 2023 no later than 5pm	Final deadline to submit questions.	
August 30, 2023	EBCE to provide Q&A document, inclusive of all questions received by deadline to submit questions	
September 13, 2023 no later than 5pm	Offers due. Offers must be submitted via Dropbox, including all required files and related information.	



RFO Process Overview

Weeks of September 18-25, 2023	EBCE interviews to be held upon EBCE discretion.	
Week of September 25, 2023	Shortlisting notification and negotiation on final terms begins.	
Week of October 16, 2023	 Negotiations completed, including: Final portfolio description, including proposed scope of work by site Final contract terms, including PPA rates and agreed upon incentive levels Final development, construction, and commissioning schedule 	




RFO Process Overview: Next Step
