




How to Find Your Vintage Year

Starting April 2020, Ava Community Energy's generation rates are based on your "vintage year." Rate sheets can be found at AvaEnergy.org/rates.

To get your vintage year, find the line on your PG&E bill that reads "Total PG&E Electric Delivery Charges." The smaller text below indicates your vintage year, which is applied to both the Power Charge Indifference Adjustment and the Franchise Fee Surcharge:
