This month, residents are receiving an electricity bill credit from the State of California. Plus, we're celebrating Back to School Night with the Oakland Roots, sharing a construction update from Sequoia Grove, and spotlighting California's new MyFirstEV program.

Look for the California Climate Credit on Your Next Bill



In August and September, residents will see lower electricity bills thanks to the California Climate Credit.

The California Climate Credit is funded by the State of California's Cap-and-Invest Program, which collects money from large polluters. Every year, some of that money is used by California to fight climate change, and some goes directly to customers in the form of a bill credit.

This year, residents will receive an electric credit of \$36.18 in August and \$36.18 in September. The credits are automatically applied to eligible customers' PG&E bills—no action needed.

MyFirstEV: Point-of-Sale Discounts for First-Time Electric Vehicle Buyers

Californians buying or leasing their first zero-emission vehicle (ZEV) can now get \$3,500 off a new model or \$1,750 off a used one from participating manufacturers. This is a point-of-sale discount, and can be stacked with other EV incentives. Availability varies by manufacturer and dealership.
